

# **TRAFFIC IMPACT NOTICE**

Due to New Jersey Transit and New Jersey Department of Transportation upgrades to the Harristown Railroad Crossing, Harristown Road will be closed to vehicular traffic from Glen Avenue to Stonefield Road. The planned dates of construction are Thursday September 27<sup>th</sup> to Friday October 5<sup>th</sup>. While the police department asked that this construction be completed during the summer months, NJ Transit and NJDOT were unable to meet that request.

While work crews are actively working, there will be a police officer present to assist pedestrians with safely traversing the work zone. There will be no interruptions to students walking to or from the schools. The crossing guard who was previously posted at Harristown and Stonefield has been moved to Harristown and Glen to better accommodate pedestrian needs.

Parents who wish to drive their children to or from the High/ Middle school or Hamilton school and your normal route takes you across the Harristown crossing, you will still be able to access the area by following the detours for local traffic.
